Facilities sanitization

Our facilities department is responding proactively. We have cleaned the Wenatchee Convention Center and sanitized it, following best practices for sanitization to prevent the spread of illness. Custodians focused their efforts on sanitizing high contact, high traffic and common areas.

Our Facility is currently being cleaned using anti-viral cleaners. We will continue to follow these practices to prevent the spread of illness, as recommended by the [Washington State Department of Health](#) and the [CDC](#).

Staying healthy

To ensure the health of everyone in our facility, employees and attendees are advised to practice good hygiene, wash their hands thoroughly and frequently and stay at home if they're feeling sick. We also recommend you adhere to the following CDC guidelines:

- [Stay home if you are sick](#) and avoid close contact with people who are sick;
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth;
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash;
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe;
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing;
- If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
